Total Number of Vehicle Stops or Contacts: 2950

Of the total number of stops (2950), 2194, could be classified as racial or ethnic minorities (this amounts to 74.3% of the total number of vehicle stops or contacts). This overall percentage is based on having identified those classes of ethnic or racial minorities within the total number of vehicle stops or contacts.

Comparative Analysis:

Those identified as minorities include a total of 874 African Americans (27.45%) and 1529 Hispanic Americans (47.9%). A comparative analysis of the most recent population statistics for the City of Kirby suggests that the percentage of African American within the overall population is 14.6% and 52.6% for Hispanic Americans. The remainder of the stops included 1.3% Asian and 23.05% Caucasian. Traffic stops conducted by all officers were predominately male (1896 {59.45%} with 1293 {40.54%} females)

Disposition of the Stops:

Disposition of the stops made by officers includes the issuance of citations and warnings totaling: 1858 citations, and 1288 warnings. 256 searches were conducted as a result of the stops. 8 stops subsequently lead to a lawful arrest, 212 searches were subsequent to a vehicle impoundment, and 21 searches resulted in the seizure of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.

During the 2014 reporting period, no racial profiling complaints were received by the department.

Information contained within this analysis will be discussed with the officers at a scheduled patrol meeting in April.
