

## Racial profiling Comparative Analysis for 2015

### Total Number of Vehicle Stops or Contacts: 2460

Of the total number of stops (2460), 1934, could be classified as racial or ethnic minorities (this amounts to 78.6% of the total number of vehicle stops or contacts). This overall percentage is based on having identified those classes of ethnic or racial minorities within the total number of vehicle stops or contacts.

### Comparative Analysis:

Those identified as minorities include a total of 693 African Americans (28.17%) and 1194 Hispanic Americans (48.54%). A comparative analysis of the most recent population statistics for the City of Kirby suggests that the percentage of African American within the overall population is 14.6% and 52.6% for Hispanic Americans. The remainder of the stops included 1.22% Asian, 0.45% Middle Eastern, 0.24% Native American and 21.38% Caucasian. Traffic stops conducted by all officers were predominately male (1437 {58.41%} with 1023 {41.59%} females). When comparing the percentage of traffic stops to the City's demographics it is important to note that of the 2460 total stops, only 544 (22.11%) were Kirby residents. The remaining 1916 (77.89%) stops represent non-resident traffic moving through the City.

### Disposition of the Stops:

Disposition of the stops made by officers includes the issuance of citations and warnings totaling: 1497 citations, and 939 warnings. 230 searches were conducted as a result of the stops. 64 stops subsequently lead to a lawful arrest, 160 searches were subsequent to a vehicle impoundment, and 25 searches resulted in the seizure of illegal drugs or drug paraphernalia.

During the 2015 reporting period, no racial profiling complaints were received by the department.

Information contained within this analysis will be discussed with the officers at a scheduled patrol meeting in April.
