Racial Profiling Comparative Analyst Report for 2015

Southside Independent School District encompasses a total of 125 square miles in Southeast Bexar County. Its boundary includes the southern edge of City of San Antonio and extends south to the Atascosa County line.

Southside I.S.D is comprised of a total of nine campuses one high school, an early college campus, one intermediate campus, one middle school, an alternative campus and four elementary campuses.

Southside I.S.D has an enrollment totaling 5,587 students on its campuses along with 816 employees. The student body ethnicity is comprised of the following; 90.21 % Hispanic, 7.59% White, 0.23% Asian, 1.45% Black of African American, 0.02% American Indian or Alaska Native and 0.07% Races Two or More 0.43% (Information obtained from 2015 PEIMS report).

From January 1, 2015 through December 31, 2015 the Southside I.S.D Police Department personnel conducted three traffic stops, all traffic stops were on school district property. During the traffic stops no vehicles were searched, no contraband was found and no arrests made based on the traffic stops. All violators were cited for the traffic infraction and released thereafter.
