Racial Profiling Report 2016

Analysis

Since January 1, 2002, the Katy Independent School District police department in accordance with the Texas Code of Criminal Procedures Article 2.132 (b)(7), has been collecting police contact data for the purpose of identifying and responding to concerns regarding racial profiling practices.

The data analysis documented within the Racial Profiling Report for the 2015 calendar year suggests that the Katy Independent Police Department is not currently experiencing a problem regarding racial profiling practices. This is also supported by the fact that no complaints from community members regarding officers misconduct associated with racial profiling practices have been received. I can also certify that this agency has adopted rules and regulations as required by the Code of Criminal Procedure Art. 2.132 (b).

The continuing effort to collect police contact data and periodic observation of officers' contact with community members will assure an on-going evaluation of the Katy Independent School District Police Department practices. This will allow for the citizens of the community to benefit from professional and courteous service from their police department.
